



Gear lever housing


To remove

- 1 Prise off and slide up the rubber boot on the gear lever, remove the screws securing the bezel for the boot and remove the bezel.
- 2 Remove the two screws securing the centre console at the front.




1 Bezel securing screw2 Console securing screw


3 Remove the brush-seal plate for the handbrake lever.



4 Release the switch panel and pull off the connectors.



5 Slide both front seats forward and release the rear securing bolts for the centre console. Remove the ashtray with the electric cables connected.




6 Lift off the centre console.




7 Remove the side trim from the front centre console.




8 Remove the securing screws and slide back the rear air duct.




9 Remove the front air duct from the heater box and slide it forward towards the bulkhead.




10 Remove the four bolts retaining the gear lever assembly.



11 Release the gear lever from the selector rod and keep the bushes, sleeve and spring washer. Lift off the gear-lever assembly.
